Ministries Within Kehilat Shiloh

Kehilat Shiloh is family fellowship of believers that came together under the Truth within the Scriptures with emphasis on the true meaning, intent, and context of the original source writings of the Torah, the Tanakh, the Apostolic Scriptures, and other Deuterocanonical texts such as the Apocrypha. We teach and preach out of the Torah and the Tanakh from their original Hebrew texts and understanding as well as the Brit Chadashah from their original Aramaic and Greek using the Berean approach of study.

We live, love, and worship as a community in observation of the Torah and His principles within it:

- *Observation of the Friday evening Erev Shabbat and the Saturday Shabbat services with public oneg.
- *Observation of the monthly Rosh Chodesh services and sighting of the new moon.
- *Observation of the Feast Holidays of Pesach, Shavuot, Yom Teruah, Yom Kippur, and Sukkot.
- *Observation of the dietary laws such as the prohibitions of pork, shellfish, catfish, and blood.
- *Observation of the tithe and the practice of benevolence to others in need of assistance.
- *Observation of the Great Commission to preach the Good News and to disciple others in Yeshua.
- *Observation within the best of our ability of the Ten Commandments and others in the Scriptures.

In addition to maintaining a benevolence fund as well as the worship services and Scripture studies on Shabbat, Rosh Chodesh, and the Feast Holidays, Kehilat Shiloh also serves as the supervising church ministry of a religious community organization under IRS Code Section 501(d) called Kibbutz Shiloh as part of its ministry service. Members of the kibbutz must first also be members of this Kehilat to qualify for membership under the Federal statutes governing 501(d) religious communities.
