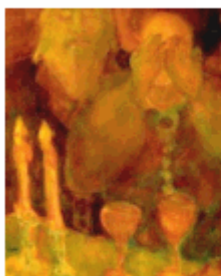

The Worship Leader and the Elders are to cover all prayer and mikvah needs before continuing with the service.)

(TITHES & OFFERINGS)

“For the LORD loveth a cheerful giver”

(At this time in the service the Worship Leader & the Elders are to direct the congregation to present any tithes, offerings, and donations otherwise that attendees had prepared to give at the service. Once the tithes, offerings, and donations are gathered together a blessing of thanksgiving is prayed over the gifts, and another prayer of thanksgiving is prayed over the givers that the work of their hands continue to be blessed and that their provision be more so blessed over time.)

CLOSING BLESSING

May Adonai bless you and guard you, shine His countenance upon you, and grant you peace.

May it be the will of our Father in Heaven to place in your heart the love and fear of Him.

May the holy fear of Adonai be upon your face all the days of your life so that you will not sin.
